Foreign Transaction fee up to 1% of each transaction amount applies to purchases made outside of the U.S., regardless of whether you are located inside or outside the United States at the time of the transaction. Charitable donation not applicable for existing cardholders converting to Pink card. Joint account holders will both receive a Pink Visa Credit Card. Effective October 1, 2024, to October 31, 2024, subject to change or cancellation without notice.



Shared Branching: It's Not a Secret!

If you don't already know about Shared Branching, then we want to let you in on what should not be a secret. Shared Branching is a national network of credit unions that share facilities to give members access to thousands of locations to perform financial transactions. This service is free for VLFCU members, and all you need is your VLFCU account number and a government-issued photo ID. Once your identity is verified, you can access your account history, make a loan payment, withdraw funds, transfer funds, make deposits, and cash checks.

This convenient service is ideal for travel, military personnel, college students, and any other occasion when you are away from your home VLFCU branch.

KINDNESS MATTERS: Home Improvement Scam with a Happy Ending

Janet and her husband Gene are Sandusky residents. They hired a painter to do exterior painting of their home. They learned of a painter working at a neighbor's home. A quote for \$1,500 from C Hayes Painting, LLC, based in Vermilion, was put in their mailbox. They accepted the quote. In April he was paid a \$750 down payment for materials and to be put on the schedule. On June 15, 2024, he said he needed another \$500 before he could begin. Janet and her husband reluctantly paid it. He completed less than 50% of the job. Despite multiple calls, he never returned the calls and he never returned to complete the painting.

Janet met with Dan McLaughlin, Erie County's Financial Elder Abuse Investigator. Janet was advised to file a police report.

In the meantime, Dan contacted a friend and retired attorney, Donald Harris, who knew of three very giving and caring men who said they would finish the job as volunteers.

"They did a beautiful job," said Janet. "We are so fortunate that they did this for us."

Thanks to Sherwin-Williams' Assistant Manager Pat Dolan, District Manager Ryan Hilman, and Store Manager Colton Veler, two gallons of paint were donated, of the five gallons needed to complete the work.

It was the kindness of others that gave this home improvement scam a happy ending.
